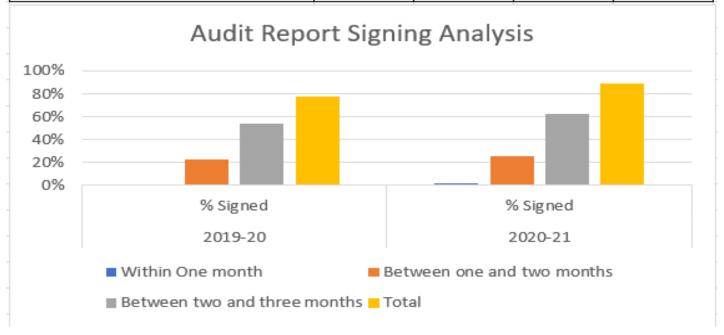

Concluded for the majority of entities that:

 key elements of internal control were operating effectively to provide reasonable assurance that the entities were able to prepare financial statements that are free from material misstatement.

- Total findings 165 (2019-20: 145)
- 2 significant (2019-20: 2)

- 14 Legislative Breaches (2019-20: 3)

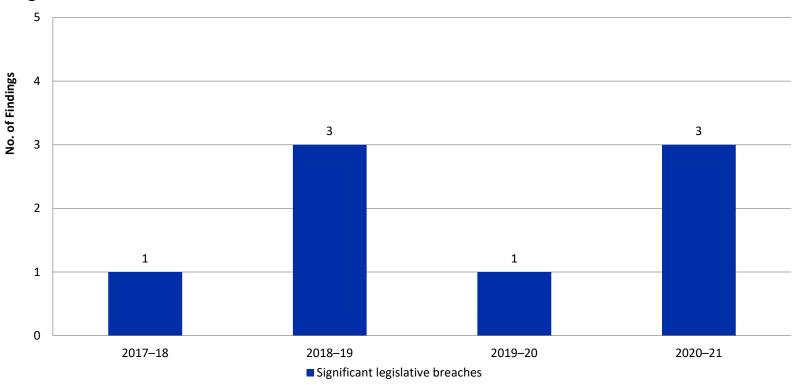
• 87.1% (2019-20: 78%) of moderate findings related to IT controls; Compliance and quality assurance frameworks; Management of non-financial assets; and Legislative Breaches.



Significant Legislative Breaches



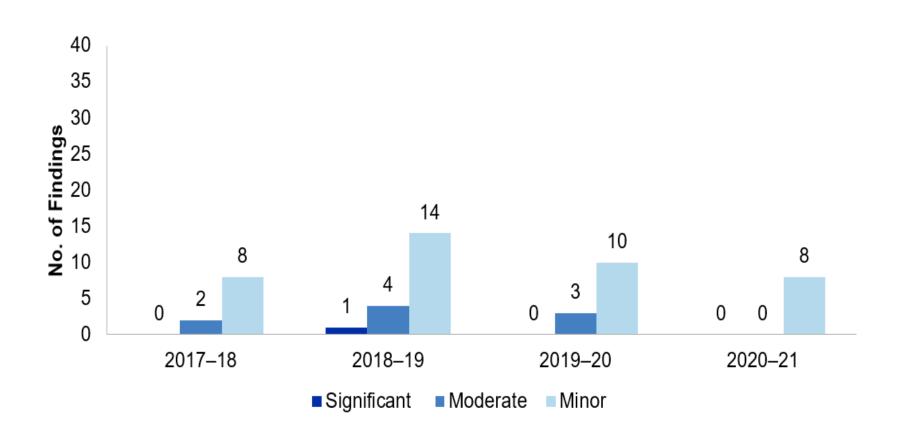

Quality of FS Preparation

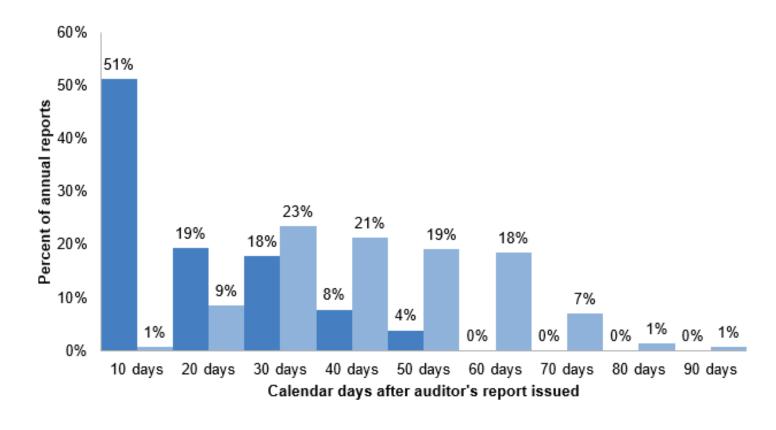

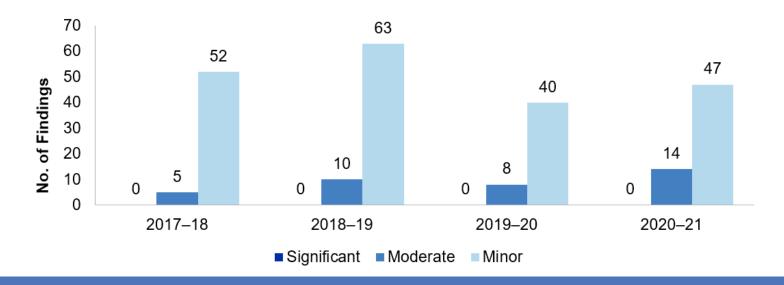

IT Controls and Cyber Security



- Cyber security remains a strategic priority for the Australian Government.
- ISM Security Control 0430 specifies that access is removed or suspended on the same day personnel no longer have a legitimate requirement for access.
- Analysis of 18 entities selected on the basis of their: contribution to the income, expenses, assets and liabilities of the 2020–21 CFS; requirement to annually report against the PSPF; and IT risk and complexity.
- 8 of 18 entities did not adequately implement Security Control 0430.





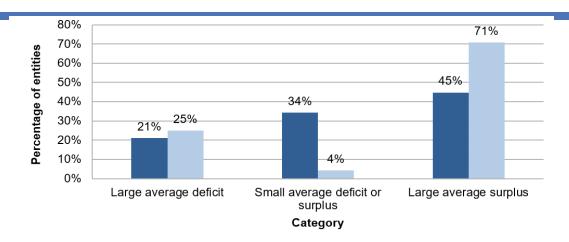
Integral to an audit is an understanding of an entity and its environment, including an entity's financial sustainability. Financial sustainability measures the ability of an entity to manage its financial resources so it can meet present and future spending commitments. ANAO undertook analysis on the operating results and balance sheet of material entities.



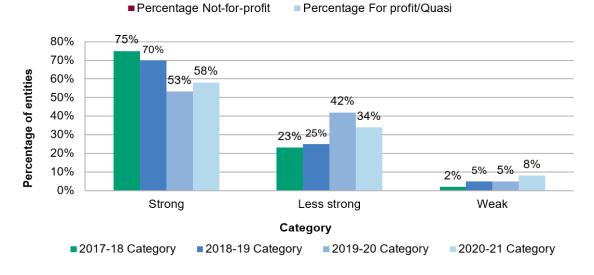
Financial Sustainability

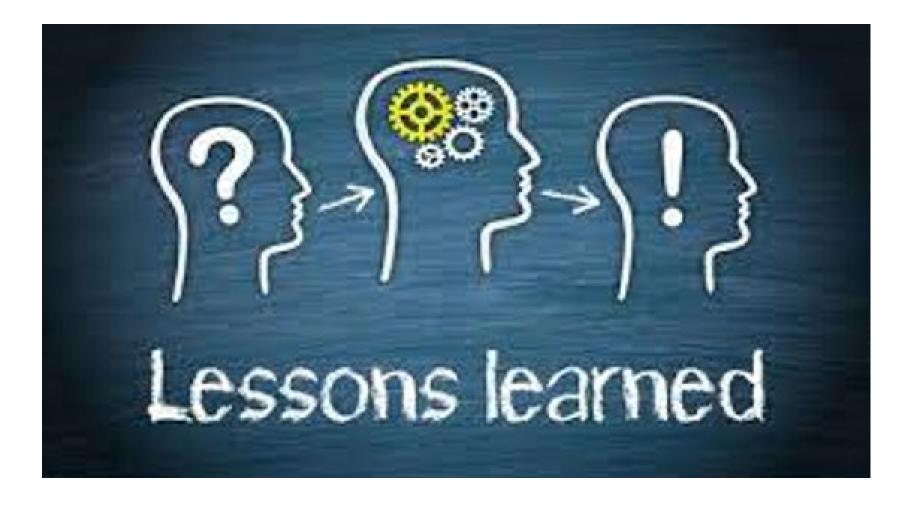
